



## **Gourmet Boat**

### **Conditions for Picking Up the Electric Boat**

Anyone can drive the boat; no boating license is required.

At the time of pickup, the following will be provided:

- Instructions and a manual on how to properly use the boat
- A map of the lake, including the menu, points of interest, attractions, and suggestions
- A box with everything needed for lunch or dinner, plus water and wine (beer upon request)
- Picnic set

### **Operating Hours**

The service is available from Thursday to Monday, for lunch and dinner, starting from April 10, 2025, until September 30, 2025.

In April and September:

- from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM
- from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM

In May, June, July, and August:

- from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM
- from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM
- from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM

It is possible to extend the service upon request and availability (with an additional fee of €40 per hour).

Guests are kindly requested to arrive approximately 15 minutes before the scheduled time.

### **Pricing**

- €240 per couple
- €80 per additional guest
- Security deposit of €1,000 (including VAT), to be paid by credit card (no AMEX) or in cash at the time of boat pickup.

Service is available for a minimum of 2 people and a maximum of 5.

### **Booking Conditions**

A credit card is required as a guarantee when booking, and no immediate charges will be made. Cancellations are allowed up to 72 hours before the appointment. The management reserves the right to charge a penalty of €50 per person from the credit card in case of:

- Cancellation within less than 72 hours for reasons not related to weather conditions
- No-show without prior notice

In case of bad weather on Lake Mergozzo, it will be the responsibility of the management to contact clients to reschedule the booking for a new date or, by mutual agreement, change the experience to a lunch/dinner at the restaurant.

### **Electric Boat Instruction Manual**

- Stay 50 meters from the shore when cruising along the lake
- When docking at the pier, approach the left side where the fenders are located and secure the boat
